Art Competition T&C's

1. The promoter is: East Coast Credit Union Ltd whose registered office is at Main Street, Bray, County Wicklow.

2. The competition has the following age groups in each category.

- 7 years & under
- 8 – 10 years inclusive
- 11 – 13 years inclusive
- 14 – 17 years inclusive

Ages as of 31st May 2026. Proof of month and year of birth may be requested by the credit union.

3. The competition is open to residents of the Republic of Ireland aged 17 years or under except The Credit Union employees or volunteers. The competition is open to members and non-members of The Credit Union.

4. The text of the theme does not have to be illustrated on your artwork. We are looking for your interpretation of the theme through your art.

5. Name, address, month and year of birth and other details (where applicable) must be clearly printed on the entry form and then attached to the back of the entry. Any entries bearing incomplete entry forms may not be considered.

6. The closing date for receipt of entries is 31ST of May. No late entries will be accepted after this date.

7. All entry forms and artworks must be certified by a parent or guardian (under 18) as being the unaided and original work of the entrant.

8. Entries must be delivered by post or by hand to East Coast Credit Union, Credit Union House, Main Street Bray, Co. Wicklow or East Coast Credit Union, 3 Main Street, Corporation Lands, Co. Wicklow.

9. All entries must be submitted in either A3 (420 x 297mm) or A2 (594 x 420mm) and landscape orientation. Portrait oriented entries will be disqualified from adjudication.

10. The entry can be drawn or painted in pencil, charcoal, pen or ink, felt-tip markers, crayon, pastel, water colours, gouache, acrylics, oils, poster colour or collage. Prints done from a lino block, wood block or any other method may also be submitted. No computer aided design (CAD) may be entered. No pieces of art under glass, as we cannot be responsible for same.

11. Competition winners will be assessed and selected by a panel of judges using the following criteria;

- Age
- Use of Colour
- Creativity
- Presentation
- Interpretation of the theme

12. Late, incomplete, or otherwise ineligible entries will be disqualified. Only one entry will be accepted per person. Multiple entries from the same person will be disqualified.

13. Prizes will be awarded in each age category alongside an overall general winner.
Overall Winner: €50 Artlab Voucher + Supply Hamper worth €100
Age Group prize: Mini supply hampers with value of over €50

14. Parent/Guardian of individual prize winners will be contacted directly by the Credit Union.

15. Prize giving ceremony will take place in June 2026 in East Coast Credit Union, Bray. Winners will be contacted with final details of the event.

16. There is no cash alternative to the prize and unless agreed otherwise in writing by The Credit Union the prize is non-refundable and non-transferable.

17. We reserved the right not to award prizes in any category. The decision of the adjudicators is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

18. The copyright in all artworks exhibited in the East Coast CU Art competition will remain the property of the entrant. However, it is a condition of entry that the East Coast CU shall and is hereby granted a non-exclusive, transferable, sub-licensable, royalty-free, irrevocable licence, please refer to the Legal Notices section.

19. This document contains the entire of the terms, conditions and rules of the competition, save where otherwise expressly stated herein, and you agree to be bound by them and them alone. You acknowledge, confirm and agree that the terms conditions and rules shall prevail over any terms, conditions, representations or statements inconsistent herewith and appearing in any advertisement, sticker, letter, flyer or any other document. Any terms, conditions, representations, statements, warranties or advertisements inconsistent with the terms, conditions and rules set out in this document are expressly excluded and the Promoter is not bound by them.

26. If the winner cannot be contacted within 30 days or are not able or available to accept the prize for any reason, then The Credit Union reserves the right to award the prize to another entrant.

27. Entries that do not comply in full with these terms and conditions will be disqualified.

28. Prizes must be collected within 30 days of the winner being notified. If not collected within this time period, prizes will be withdrawn and/or offered to other entrants in The Credit Union's absolute discretion.

29. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter the competition.

30. **Legal Notices**

Consent: The entrant (or, where aged 16 or under or otherwise not capable of giving consent on their own behalf, their parent/guardian on their behalf) warrants that (i) the artworks complies with all of the eligibility and entry requirements set out in these Rules; (ii) the entrant is the owner of and holds the copyright in the artworks; and (iii) the entrant consents to, and has obtained the consent of the sitter to, use the artworks and the sitter's personal details in the manner set out in these Rules.

Copyright: The copyright in all artworks exhibited in the East Coast CU Art competition will remain the property of the entrant. However, it is a condition of entry that the East Coast CU shall and is hereby granted a non-exclusive, transferable, sub-licensable, royalty-free, irrevocable licence: (i) to reproduce images of the artworks for publicity, informational, educational, reference and all broadcast and digital purposes in connection with the Art competition, Art competition publication and any subsequent publications; (ii) to crop the image of their artwork as needed to fit various formats in relation the purposes mentioned above (iii) to provide images to third parties such as national and international press/broadcasters in connection with the Art competition; (iv) to use a representation of the winning artworks for any advertising, marketing, promotional or other purposes; and (v) should the East Coast CU wish to produce commercial products containing or comprising copies of artworks for sale (such as posters, postcards etc.), a standard royalty will be offered to the entrants as well as a set number of copies for their own use.

The East Coast CU may, but shall not be obliged to, film and broadcast the processes of the Art competition. The shortlisted artists will be asked if they wish to provide permission to allow members of the public to photograph their artwork in the East Coast CU for non-commercial use. Tripods, monopods and flashlights will be prohibited at all times. Shortlisted artists will retain the right to refuse permission to this request.

The shortlisted artists will be asked if they wish to provide permission for a non-exclusive, sub-licensable, royalty-free, irrevocable licence for the East Coast CU to reproduce and crop images of their artwork for publicity and digital purposes in connection with the Art competition. Shortlisted artists retain the right to refuse permission to this request.
